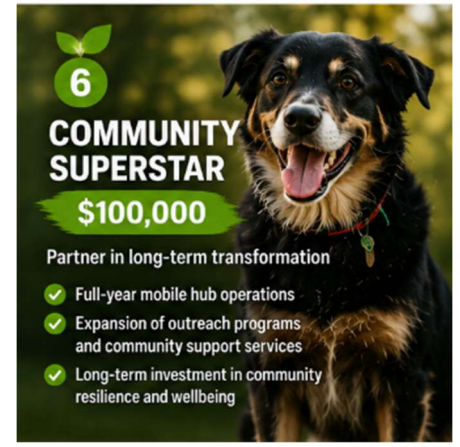

PROGRAM LOGIC

PROGRAM AIM

To reduce isolation and improve access to essential support services for communities in the Far South of the Huon Valley by delivering flexible, person-centred, place-based support that strengthens wellbeing, connection and participation.

ACTIVITIES

- Deliver one-on-one support to individuals and families in the Far South communities
- Provide information, advocacy and supported referrals to services
- Assist people to access health, wellbeing, housing, financial and social supports
- Identify emerging needs early and work alongside community to address needs providing practical assistance where possible
- Facilitate social connection opportunities and pathways into community activities
- Build trust with isolated and vulnerable community members through regular contact and visibility
- Work collaboratively with partner organisations to coordinate local response and map services

OUTCOMES

SHORT-TERM

- Increased awareness of available services and supports
- Improved access to information and referrals
- Increased trust in local and visiting support services
- Reduced immediate barriers to help-seeking
- Increased feelings of being supported and connected
- Identification of unmet community needs and risks

MEDIUM-TERM

- Improved access to health, community and wellbeing services
- Reduced social isolation and sense of loneliness
- Increased confidence to seek help and navigate services independently
- Greater participation in local activities and peer networks
- Increased capacity for DASAG volunteers to provide information and support
- Stronger coordination between local services and support providers

LONG-TERM

- More connected, resilient and inclusive Far South communities
- Reduced disadvantage caused by geographic isolation
- Improved wellbeing and quality of life for vulnerable residents
- Greater equity and support for rural and remote communities
- Stronger local systems of care of community support

This program logic is based on the following assumptions:

- *People are more likely to engage when support is local, flexible and relationship-based*
- *Outreach reduces barriers created by distance, transport and service complexity*
- *Early intervention prevents escalation of hardship and crisis*
- *Strong local partnerships improve service coordination and outcomes*
- *Community connection is a protective factor for wellbeing*
